Pre-Kindergarten Programs

Key Features

- ◆ Pre-Kindergarten programs within an elementary school offer age appropriate academic environments in a nurturing, structured setting. One class is offered for 3-year-olds and one class is offered for 4-year-olds.
- ◆ Children for the PreK3 program must be 3-years-old before September 1, 2017. Children for the PreK4 program must be 4-years-old before September 1, 2017. Children must be potty-trained to attend.
- ◆ Both 3-day (Mon-Wed-Fri) and 5-day options are available. 5-day students are given preference for enrollment. Hours for full day PreK are 8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.
- ◆ Large, colorful, engaging, technology-equipped classrooms encourage students to explore and participate in the curriculum. There is a dedicated playground for recess and outdoor play.
- ◆ Children learn to transition as they move throughout the school to assemblies, music class, the library, and to the gym for physical education. Children experience other adults (teachers) in these classes.
- ◆ After school CARE program is offered for an additional fee. Students must be picked up before 6:00 p.m.

Examples of Daily Routine and Activities

- ◆ Circle Time which includes prayer, Pledge of Allegiance, songs, morning message, reading a book of the week, vocabulary practice, letter of the week and phonics work
- ◆ Group work with an interactive smartboard including science lessons and math
- ◆ Small group work with journal writing and art projects
- ◆ Nutrition program sponsored by the Dairy Council to encourage trying new foods
- ◆ Fields trips to learn about nature, animals, and railroads. Embryonic chicks program with Penn State 4H.
- ◆ Prayer partners with fourth grade students: writing letters to Santa, May procession, guest readers, etc.
